- All films must be appropriate for children and have the equivalent of a "G" rating for General Audiences.
- Acceptable format for submission: DVD only
- All films that are not in English must have English language subtitles.
- Each entry must be a separate submission which includes form and payment for each submission.
- Fees from outside the US must be payable in US funds. No cash is allowed.
- Only submissions with completed entry forms and entry fee will be accepted.
- Mail your entry in a padded envelope or mailer box.
- If you have listed a valid email address we will verify that we have received your entry.
- Shorts and student shorts must be no longer than 10 minutes long.
- Releases for music and talent must be obtained by the filmmaker. The Epiphany Children's Film Festival, The Epiphany School and The Church of the Epiphany are not liable for copyright infringement or unauthorized use.
- If your film has been selected to be screened at the festival we will request you send a press kit to include: stills, posters, postcards, and other publicity materials to maximize exposure for your film. These materials will not be returned.
- If your film has been selected to be screened at the festival, we ask that it not be viewable in its entirety online on sites like MySpace or YouTube one month before, or during the festival screening. Trailers or clips from the film are acceptable.
- The Epiphany Children's Film Festival does not assume any liability for damage to films, or publicity materials.
- Non-selected films will be notified after February 1, 2011 via e-mail only.
